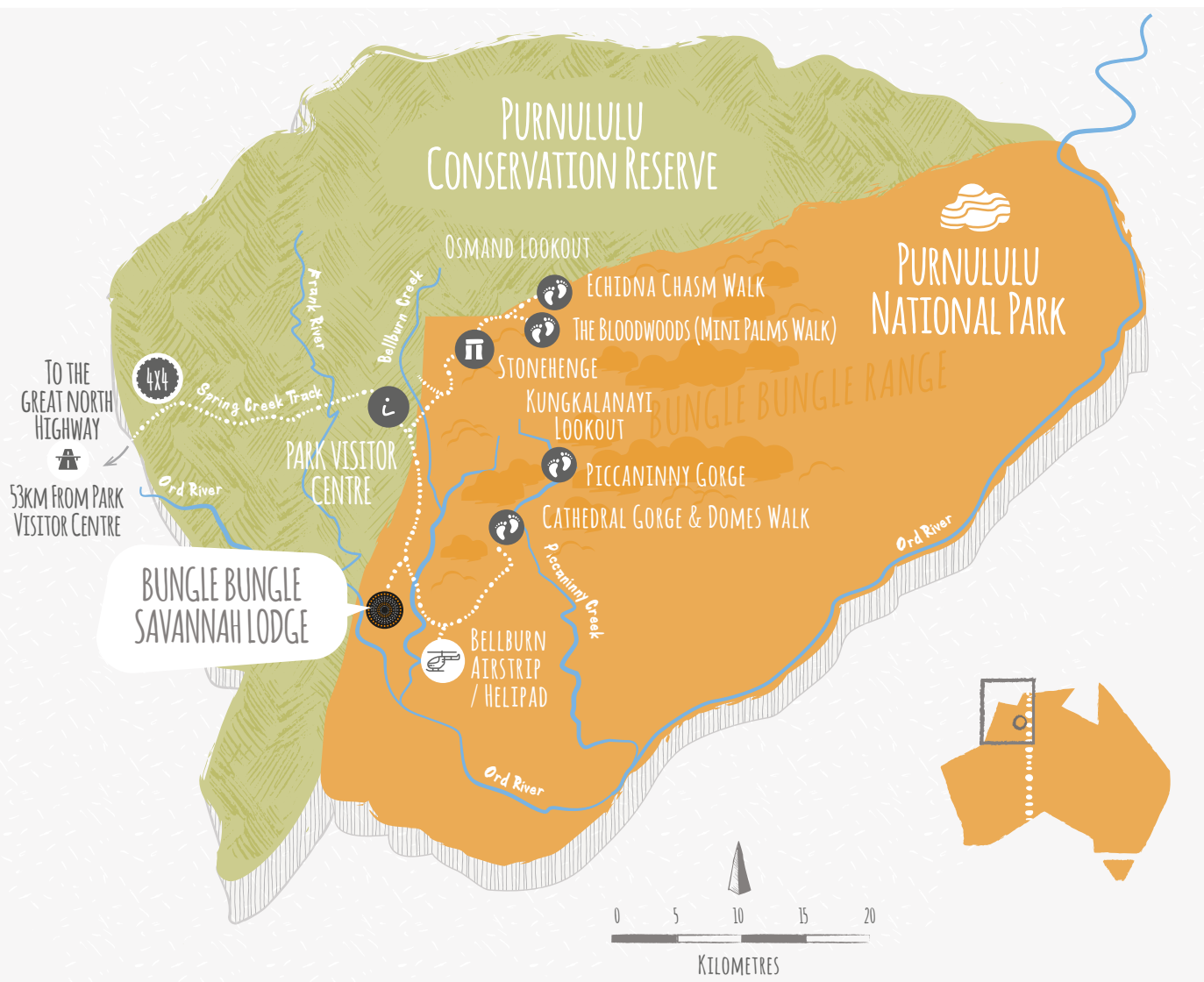

Things to Note

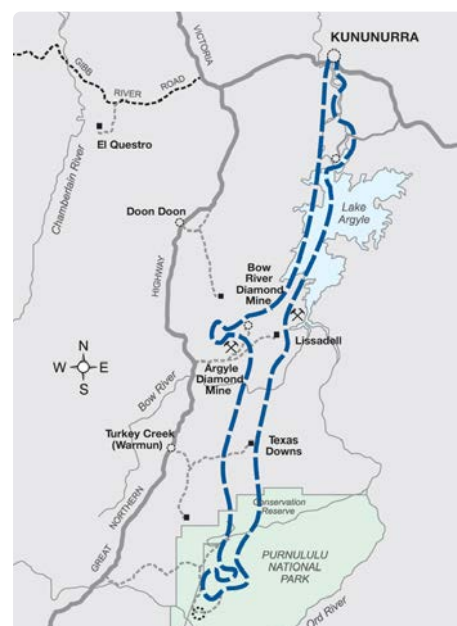
Travel time from one destination to another will vary depending on the road conditions at the time. There are two main areas of attraction within the park, being the striking black and orange banded domes, Piccaninny Creek and Cathedral Gorge at the southern end and Echidna Chasm and Mini Palms Gorge 42 kilometres away at the northern end.

Things to Bring

While travelling throughout the park it is recommended to carry a first aid kit, plenty of water to keep hydrated and light snacks for energy. It is important to wear light cotton clothing, cover up with sun protection and wear good walking shoes whilst hiking.

If staying overnight, we recommend bringing a hat, sturdy enclosed walking shoes (no leather soles), sunscreen and light sun protective clothing, day pack, torch, refillable water bottle, toiletries, camera and chargers, medication (if required) and warm clothing for cool evenings.

How to Get Here



Fly by Plane

Fly in packages are available with Aviair on their air-conditioned aircraft, with departures from Kununurra and El Questro. Two-hour scenic flights are also available from Kununurra.



Fly by Helicopter

Helicopter transfers with HeliSpirit are available from Kununurra and Lake Argyle. With helicopter tours also departing from Bungle Bungle Caravan Park and within Purnululu National Park.



Self-Drive

From Kununurra, it is approximately 252 km to the turn-off into the national park from the Great Northern Highway. From the turn-off, the 53 km drive along Spring Creek Track is only accessible to 4WD vehicles. This can take up to two hours depending on the condition of the track.



Discover the Southern End

Cathedral Gorge & Domes Guided Walk

Start your day with an unforgettable scenic flight with Aviair from Kununurra over the Ord River Irrigation Area, Diversion Dam, Carr Boyd Ranges, Osmand Ranges, the Ord River, Bow River and the magnificent Lake Argyle.

Landing at a remote unsealed airfield in Purnululu National Park, you will be picked up by your guide in an air-conditioned 4WD bus to take you closer to the Bungle Bungle Range. Enjoy a moderate 3km guided walk amongst the famous black and orange banded beehive-shaped structures on the Domes Walk.

Your guide will take you into Cathedral Gorge, where towering cliffs open up to form a space with awe-inspiring natural acoustics. Walk along the bed of Piccaninny Creek, which flows only in the monsoon waterfall season. Return via a scenic flight to Kununurra, on the way viewing the Argyle Diamond Mine where rare pink diamonds were once mined.

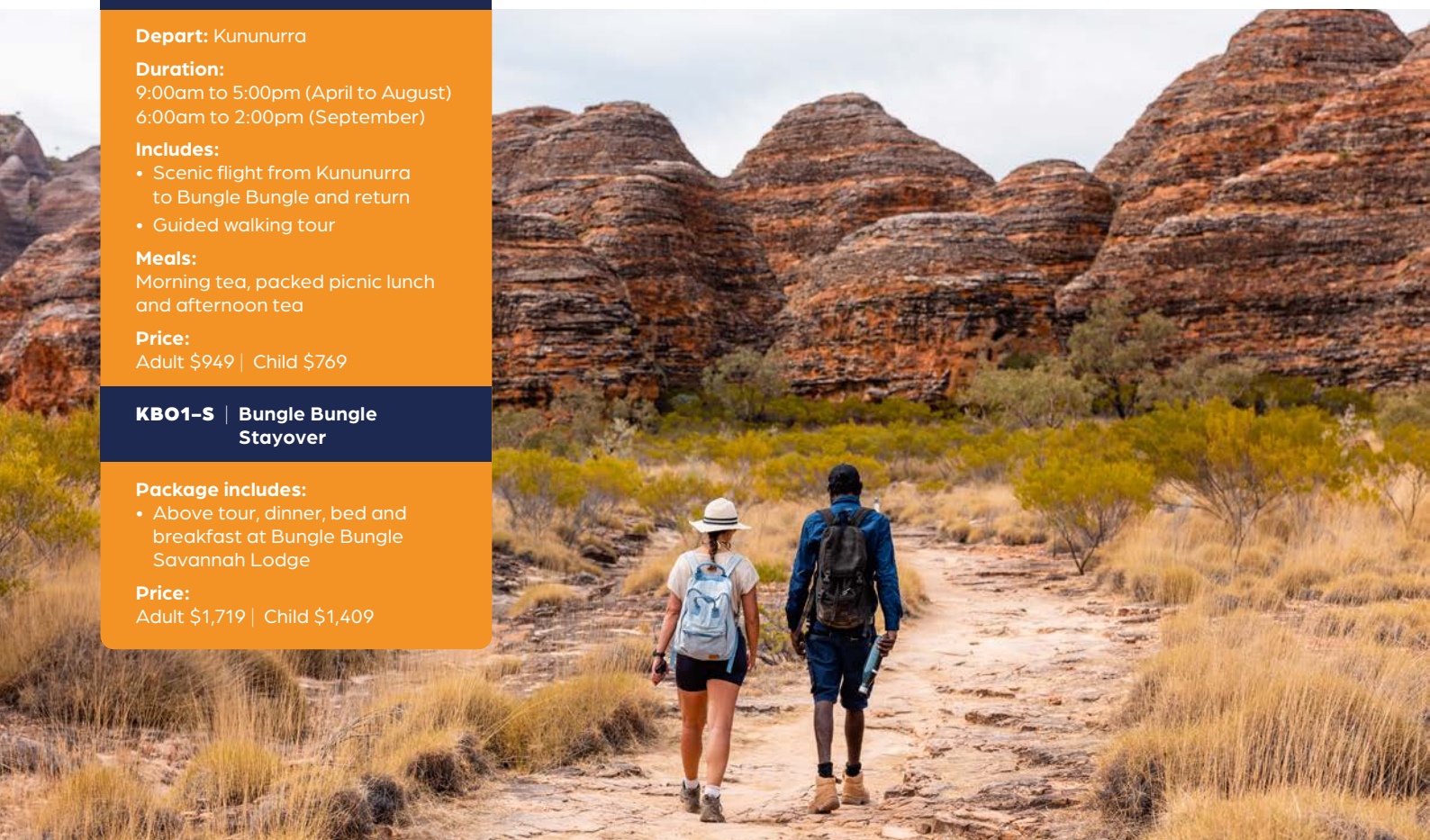

Explore the Southern & Northern Ends

Cathedral Gorge, Domes Walk & Echidna Chasm

Extend your adventure to the northern end of the park and discover the towering red rock gorges and chasms filled with Livistona palms trees.

After you explore the Domes and Cathedral Gorge in the morning, you'll then be taken on a 65-minute drive northwards along the Western Wall of the Bungle Bungle Range. A rocky path leads your walk into Echidna Chasm, which narrows until it is just two shoulders' width apart. Gazing skywards to the bright blue sky, the towering orange walls look as if they are lit from within. Livistona palms cling to the vertical sides. A good level of mobility is required for the 1.5 hour northern walk.

Note: This tour can be split over two days when booked as an overnight package.

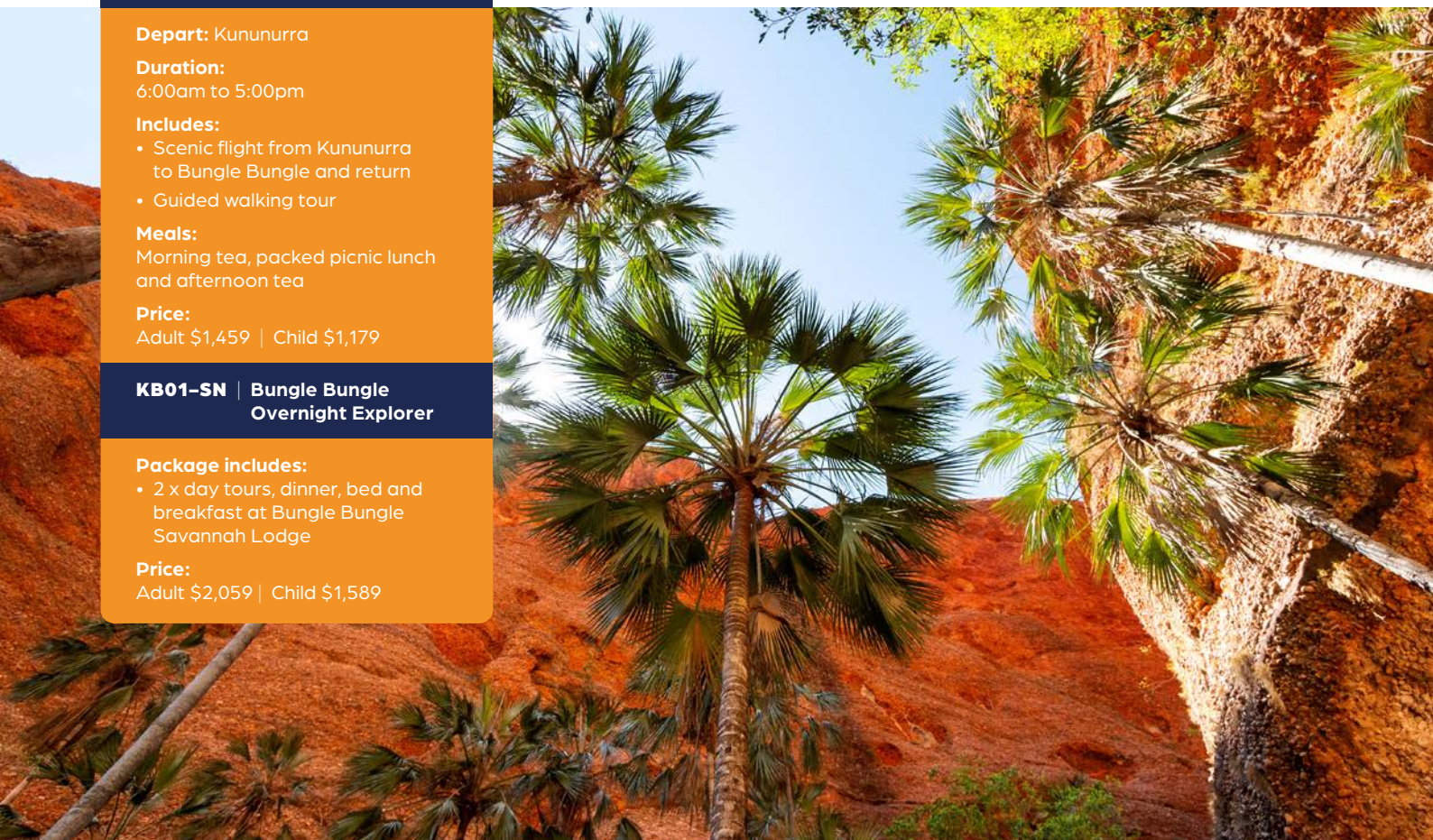

The rocky creek bed of Piccaninny Gorge is classed as a level 5 walk, with no designated track. The hike is up to 10km return and requires a high level of fitness & mobility.

Piccaninny Gorge Heli-Hike

Helicopter Flight + Piccaninny Gorge Guided Hike

Attention avid hikers – this is the tour for you!

Piccaninny Gorge has been explored by very few people as it is normally a 3-day journey on foot. This tour provides helicopter access, allowing you to explore the best parts of the Gorge in a single day. The untouched rugged gorge seems prehistoric and you will feel like you are in another world once inside. Meet your tour guide at the HeliSpirit shade area at Bellburn airstrip in Purnululu National Park. After your briefing, board a helicopter to fly over the south west of the Bungle Bungle to "Y" Gorge before soaring across the top of the enormous massif to the mouth of spectacular Piccaninny Gorge where we land. Your expert guide will lead the way as you walk where only few have explored before.

This is a challenging, yet highly scenic 10 km hike along a rocky creek bed – this is the largest of all the gorges in Purnululu National Park. Your return helicopter flight continues from the mouth of the gorge, along the southern face, following Piccaninny Creek where you can view Cathedral Gorge and soar over the famous striped beehive shaped domes.

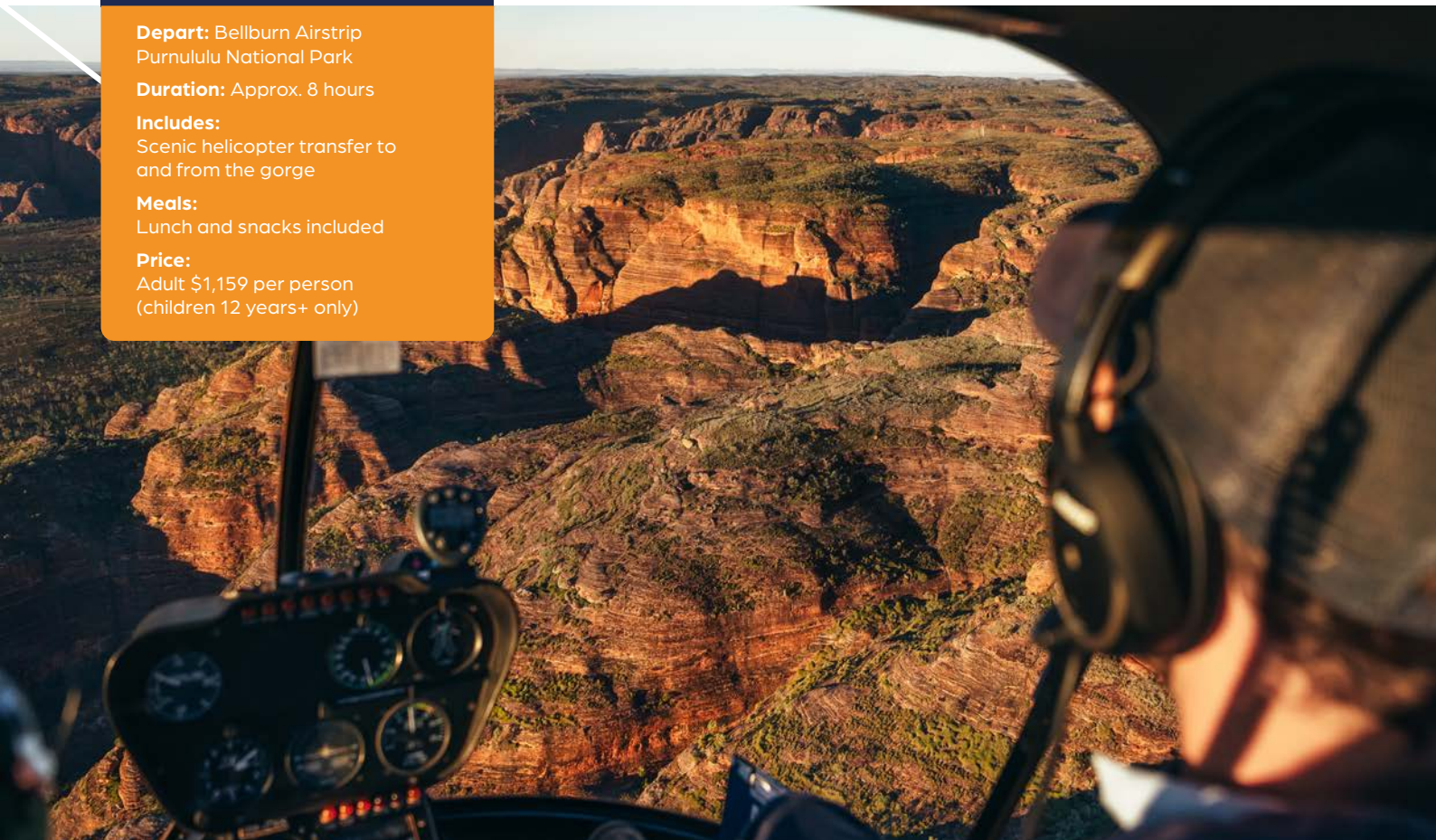

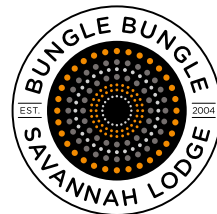

There are few lifetime experiences that can match exploring the Bungle Bungle by day and staying overnight in Purnululu National Park.

Experience a landscape 350 million years in the making, refresh in our pool, replenish with delicious meals and rest in comfort in a private cabin with ensuite bathroom. Here in Purnululu you will find one of the best stargazing spots in Australia. Discover views of the Milky Way Galaxy and see the Southern Cross, which is rarely seen from skies in the northern hemisphere.

The eco cabins feature multiple louvre windows for natural air-flow throughout, a pedestal fan, bedside tables, wall-mounted lights and comfortable hotel quality queen or king split beds. Your private ensuite is fitted with a flushing toilet, heated shower, hand basin and mirror, environmentally friendly toiletries, quality towels and 240-volt solar generated power. The lodge has one family cabin that can sleep up to two adults and two children (under 12). All other cabins sleep two guests.

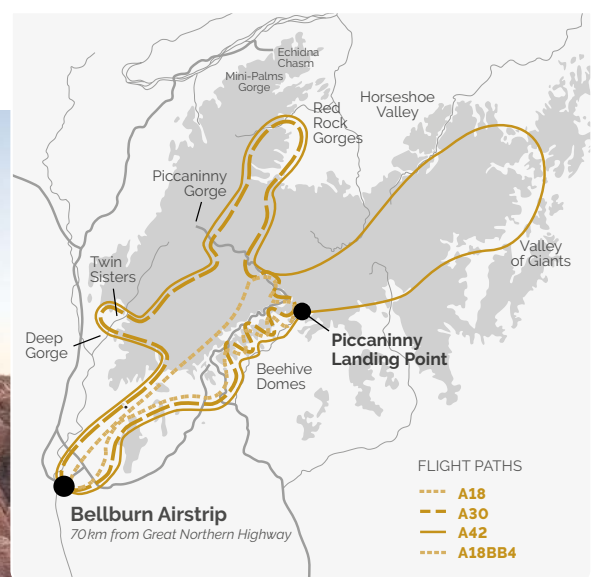
This 30-minute flight is brimming with more impressive natural features and landforms than you could imagine. Take in the remarkable hidden red rock gorges of the north-west tip and Horseshoe Valley before soaring over Piccaninny Gorge, Cathedral Gorge and the show-stopping striped Bungle Bungle domes.

A42 | The Ultimate Bungle Bungle Flight

Flight time: 42 minutes | **Cost:** \$599 per person

The name says it all, this incredible flight gives breathtaking views of Y Gorge, Deep Gorge and 'The Twins' before continuing on to the highest point of the Bungle Bungle and the spectacular red rock gorges of the north-west. Soar over the Valley of the Giants with its massive sandstone structures before following the southern face to discover the mouth of Piccaninny Gorge, Piccaninny Creek, Cathedral Gorge and the famous orange and black striped Bungle Bungle domes.

The beehive-shaped striped sandstone domes are like nothing else. Walking along Piccaninny Creek, with the domes towering above you on either side will leave you feeling captivated by this ancient place. The enormity of these landforms combined with the eye-catching orange and black banding takes you on a visual journey like no other.

Get a true sense of the scale of this ancient place by joining a guided walk, learning about the history and cultural significance of this region. Then discover the iconic Bungle Bungle Domes from above, with a thrilling helicopter flight showcasing hidden red rock gorges, Piccaninny Creek and unique beehive formations that have contributed to the addition of Purnululu National Park as one of Australia's World Heritage listed areas. Lastly, spend the night under starry skies in eco-accommodation and indulge in chef-prepared meals at Bungle Bungle Savannah Lodge.



An Ancient Landscape Awaits

As one of only 12 UNESCO Natural World Heritage sites in Australia, Purnululu National Park covers almost 240,000 hectares of remote wilderness. This region is recognised for its natural and cultural heritage, and our collection of tourism businesses work alongside the Traditional Custodians of the park to help share its rich cultural history with visitors from around the world.

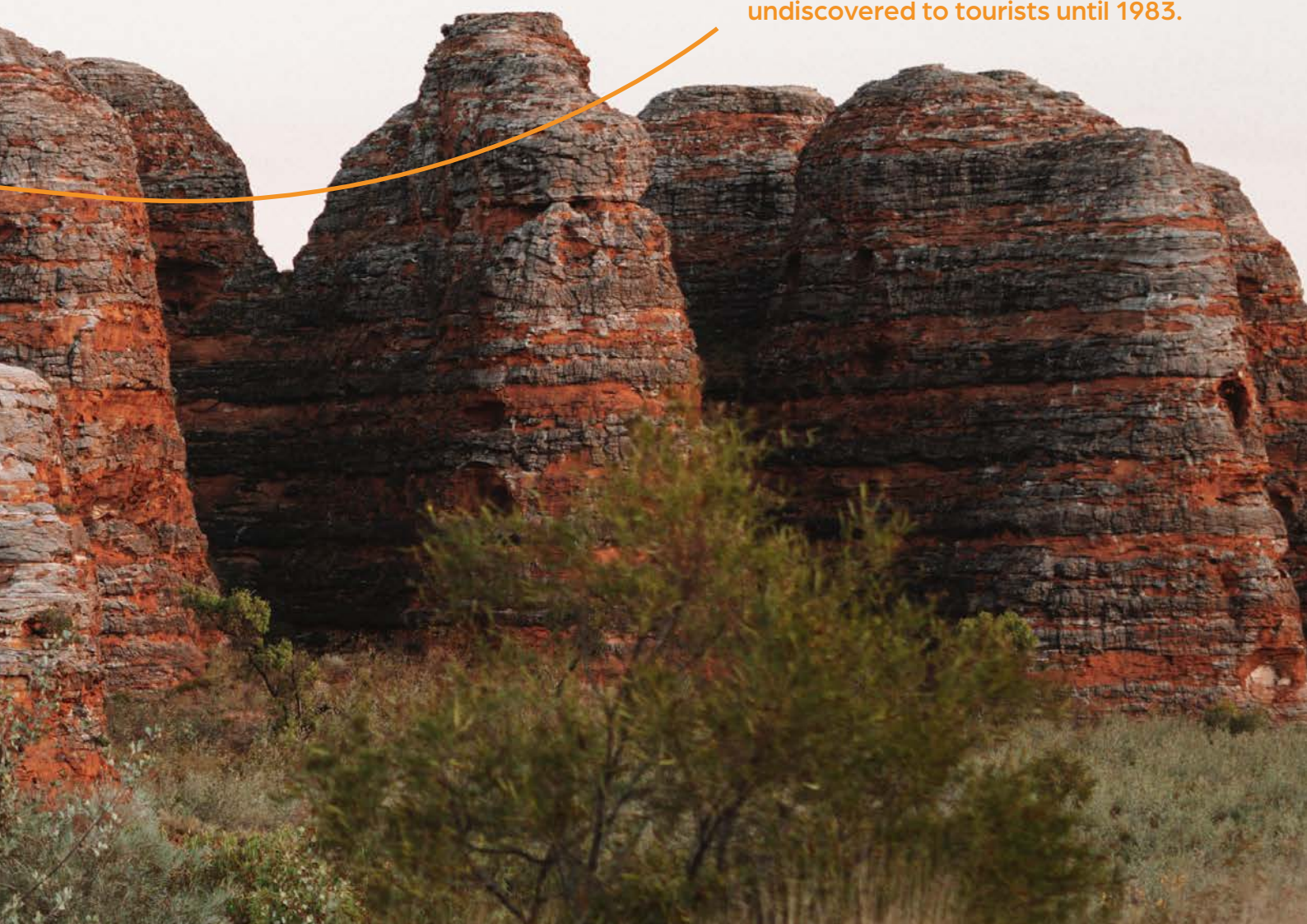
Cultural Significance

The park holds cultural significance to both Jaru and Gija people with parts of the area being used as traditional meeting places. Purnululu National Park is jointly managed by the Traditional Custodians and the Department of Biodiversity, Conservation & Attractions. Our collection of tourism businesses has made a commitment to protecting this ancient, fragile environment and is proudly accredited with EcoTourism Australia and Respecting our Culture certification.

Our guided tours will always include an experienced interpretive guide to transport you back to a time where Aboriginal people lived for some 40,000 years. We endeavour to have an indigenous cultural guide join each tour; however, we cannot guarantee this as they sometimes have other cultural duties to attend to.
